 - Schoology Learning Support Teachers were not told from PSE to set up a class in Schoology. Teachers can add Learning Support Teachers and Paraprofessionals as an owner or member to the classes they support.

- We will still be doing MAP testing. Accommodations can still be given to students who need them. Mindy will look into the possibility of screen sharing and doing the test 1:1 with a student.
