PA Covid Tracing App Reports Over 250,000 App Users Since Launch. **

Pennsylvania's state-wide Covid-19 contact tracing app has been up and running for a little over two weeks, exceeding early number-of-download projections. The phone-based interactive tracking application provides users with automatic notifications about potential coronavirus exposures.

The caveat is, the app will only work for app users who have been in close contact with other app users who have tested positive and report the result.

That means the application succeeds or fails based on the number of people who use it.
