One question that keeps coming up is how the emergence of Covid-19 variants (*new strains*) will affect the current vaccination protocols. Simply put—the variants make getting vaccinated as

soon as possible an even more urgent priority.

Here is an excerpt from the article:

Given these new variants, is there anything I can do to improve my chances of avoiding COVID-19?

Sure. Fauci and Walensky, the CDC's chief, both recommend getting immunized with one of the vaccines authorized in the U.S. as soon as you are eligible — widespread vaccination will very likely help stop the spread of whatever strains of the coronavirus are circulating in your area and lessen the development of new mutations and strains.

And continue to [keep your distance from people outside your household, wear a mask, and avoid travel and crowds](#) even after you're fully vaccinated, until the level of virus spreading in your community and any place you go is very low.

Information on Covid Vaccine Available To Expanded 1A Categories.

Clearly there are forces hard at work to secure vaccines as soon as possible for everyone within PPS who wants them (see above). However, if you are part of the recently expanded 1A category, you are eligible to receive your vaccine now. The information below may help you secure a vaccine even earlier than what might be available through the PPS partnership.
