PFT Dues (21-22 School Year) The PFT's basic dues structure in dollar amounts is outlined below for each category of membership. An additional .09% (.0009) of all earnings is dedicated to the operation of the PFT Building. This additional .09% of all earnings, as a dollar amount for each member, will vary with each member's individual earnings (95 per \$100 in earnings).

Local dues (for full time teachers and other professional members only) equals
\$50.30 dues minus \$16.70 per capita payments = \$33.60 plus the .09% dedicated dues
