Understanding Boosters – The Where's, How's and Why.

When it comes to most vaccinations, nothing lasts forever. And that includes the robust protection enjoyed by the vast majority of people who have received full or partial Covid-19 vaccinations. It's a fact of viral life that immunity – or more specifically, robust protection – will likely wane over time.

But rather than be a cause for overt concern, having a frank discussion about boosters should be reassuring and illuminating. Recently, WTAE offered an in-depth look at booster shots and waning immunity, a report that offered several reassurances that needing a vaccine booster is a logical, natural and necessary part of ongoing preventative care.

Understanding the Unvaxed—They're Not All Who You Think They Are.

Given that America has yet to surpass the 60% fully vaccinated threshold among our total population, it's reasonable to assume that the only certainty we have is that there is still a significant amount of uncertainty "out there."

But when it comes to actively seeking out and accepting a free, proven and readily available vaccine against COVID 19, the reasons so many people are still hesitating or opting out aren't always the reasons being featured on mainstream media.

Have there been large disinformation campaigns and mixed media messages?

Yes.

Is there a political and/or a racial contributor to vaccine resistance that makes a group more likely to be skeptical of vaccines overall? **Yes.**

But there are other powerful forces at work here, including:

- a lack of trust in healthcare systems that are already less accessible in many rural communities
- a lack of ready access to informed healthcare professionals to provide sound, trusted advice
- a significant number of people resisting vaccination who report a demonstrable fear of needles

Coming Soon: Vaccine Eligibility for Ages 5-11.

Breaking news in from the Associated Press this morning—federal regulators will meet over the next two weeks to weigh the safety and effectiveness of giving low-dose shots to the roughly 28 million children in that age group.

It's a moment whose time has been studied and debated for months, and in early November after the CDC advisory panel signs off on the recommendation, millions of low-doses will be distributed nationwide.

Health officials believe that expanding the vaccine drive will not only curb the alarming number of infections in children but also reduce the spread of the virus to vulnerable adults. It could also help schools stay open and youngsters get back on track academically, and contribute to the nation's broader recovery from the pandemic. -- AP
